The meeting began with a short prayer and a welcome by Sr. Delicia Fernandes, Principal In charge.

1. Reading and confirming the minutes of previous meeting

Dr. Agnes Dcosta presented the minutes of the previous meeting held on 25th April 2024 and the minutes were duly passed after being proposed by Dr. Sheetal Chaudhari and seconded by Prof Dr Cindrella Dmello.

A brief overview of the quality initiatives taken by IQAC was presented by Dr. Agnes Dcosta. These included Value Added Courses and workshops on Vedic Mathematics, physio therapy and Neuro Linguistic Programming organised by IQAC. Faculty development programmes on proposed changes by NAAC and Artificial Intelligence Tools in Research were also organised by IQAC.

2. Quality initiatives planned for 2024-25

Dr. Agnes Dcosta presented the IQAC Plan of action for 2024-25 which included conducting of Value-added courses, organisation of workshops on topic such as TET, AI in education, learning resources, stress management, classroom management skills, and gender sensitization. Other initiatives planned included organising FDPs related to the revised NAAC system and adding to existing E resources. A suggestion was made to increase MOUs for community related experiences. The draft of Institutional Development Plan was circulated to the faculty for perusal and in the same would be finalised upcoming months.

Faculty members shared the plans for their respective departments focusing on the actual programmes planned for the next six months.

3. Updates on AQAR of 2023-24

Dr Agnes Dcosta shared that work on AQAR of 2023-24 was in progress and the AQAR would be submitted by Dec 2024. As part of AQAR of 2023-24, the IQAC had conducted Student Satisfaction Survey. The results of the same were presented and it was noted that students had conveyed their positive response and satisfaction regarding the various activities conducted.

Quality initiatives taken from August 2024 to January 2025

Dr Agnes Dcosta informed that AQAR of 2023-24 was submitted to NAAC on 11 Jan 2025. She further gave details of the Brain-based teaching workshop by Mr Willibrord George held on 18 Jan 2025. The workshop was attended by about 100 preservice and inservice teachers. Quality initiatives carried out from Sept 2024 to Jan 2025 were discussed. Various activities organized under MOUs with different institutions were elucidated. Details of other quality based initiatives such as college level workshops, Value Added Courses, guest lectures were highlighted.

Quality initiatives to be taken from January 2025

The IQAC plan of action for the [eriod Feb 2025 to May 2025 was then presented. This will include value added courses on Mental Health and Communication Skills, Workshop on AI in education. programmes for faculty and staff enrichment and expert lectures on relevant themes. There will be focus on development of digital resources, research and activities related to Indian Knowledge Systems. Regular documentation and collation of semester wise feedback will continue as before.

SWOC Analysis Report

The feedback of SWOC Analysis by students and alumni was presented by Ms. Sonia Bombacha and Ms Steffi Colaco. Regular workshops use of various pedagogical approaches, focus on skill development, projects promoting social responsibility, welcoming environment for students were identified as the strengths of the college. Certain infrastructural needs were identified as weakness. More exposure to different educational boards, leveraging digital transformation, organizing more of inter collegiate skill-based competitions were listed as the challenges. The respondents also suggested leveraging data analytics as an opportunity that can be considered. The IQAC members reflected on the SWOC analysis and it was decided that the college would continue to uphold the strengths and work on the weakness and challenges.

Manager Sr Sharlet Xavier lauded the efforts of the Principal and the staff with respect to being situation ready at all times including times of visits by external team of experts. 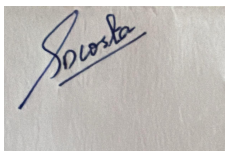

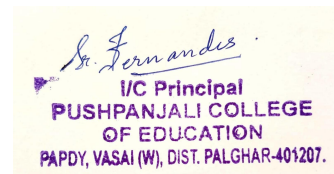
